## HEADS UPDATE

### GREAT NEWS!

I am delighted to be able to tell you about a significant milestone reached by the school yesterday. As a school we are being closely monitored by two bodies; Ofsted and the Local Authority. They carry out mini inspections every long term and come to one of two judgements - either we are taking effective action to get out of Special Measures or we are not.

Yesterday the Local Authority judged us to be taking effective action. The judgement reflects the hard work the staff have put in and the commitment to removing us from Special Measures. We are on the right track!

An inspector from Ofsted judged us as 'not taking effective action' on October 3rd this year, but this report ([website link](#)) was based on the six months after the February Inspection. We are due another visit in January when we hope to convince them as well.
