If we are not successful in recruiting the right person today then we will run another round of interviews on another day and keep going until we get the right people in place. I know how important this is and I will not settle for second best as I know you won't.

I am excited by the candidates we have coming in and hope they perform on the day wowing us with their abilities and attitude. In next week's newsletter I hope to be able to let you know who we recruited.
