## WHOLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Miss Jones, Mrs Botwright & Mr Raymond have recently met with our EWO (Education Welfare Officer) to discuss the schools overall attendance.

So far this term, 573 minutes (**9 hours and 55 minutes**) of lateness has been recorded.

We appreciate there can be a multitude of reasons why children might be late; but this can have a knock on effect to their learning and might mean they are missing out on vital curriculum subjects such as phonics.

May I take this opportunity to remind parents that children are expected to be in school ready to start learning at 8.45am. The school gates are open to those not in breakfast club from 8.35am. Those that arrive after 8.45am will be registered as late by the office. This will in turn have an impact on the child's overall attendance.

If a child has persistent attendance and the school has concerns, warning letters will be issued to parents and there is a possibility of a fine being issued by the local authority.
