HEADS UPDATE

You may or may not have noticed my absence this week from school, and I will be absent for another week I'm afraid to say. Miranda Thomas has initiated this activity but has now stepped down after 2 years as Chair and handed over to Mike Thompson. Miranda helped create a governing body that is more proactive and informed than ever before and I have been incredibly well supported by her in my role. She agreed to step in for a few weeks and ended committing for two years and has seen the school through some challenging times.

I look forward to working with Mike who has already been visiting the school regularly and building relationships with staff.
