HEADS UPDATE

'Calm'

This is how two new visiting families described our school environment, independently from each other, when they walked around earlier this week. This has taken time to develop but we now know that your children are displaying excellent learning behaviours during lesson time.

'The children are engaged in learning and motivated by the way it is being delivered by the teachers' - this is what the children said in every class when I interviewed them this week. I interviewed children from every class to get their take on their teacher and the way they were being taught. The answers were overwhelmingly positive, for example:

'The questions my teacher asks make me really think and help me learn'

'The teacher always listens to my ideas'

'I use the displays on the wall to help me when I am doing maths'

'My teacher is strict, happy and kind'

'I use the five 'B's when I am stuck—brain, board, book, buddy, boss'

'My teacher breaks things down in small steps to help me understand the work'

The children responded brilliantly to the questions and were genuinely excited to be asked. This is part of our monitoring programme that values the perception that your children have and gives each teacher a perspective from their pupils that they can then respond to.

CHICKEN POX GUIDELINES

Since being back to school this term, many children have been absent from school with the Chicken Pox virus. To ensure all parents are aware of the school guidelines, please read the information below from the NHS website:

- ◆ You can catch chickenpox by being in the same room as someone with it.
- ◆ It's also spread by touching clothes or bedding that has fluid from the blisters on it.
- ◆ Chickenpox is infectious from 2 days before the spots appear to until they have crusted over, usually 5 days after they first appeared.
- ◆ It takes 1 to 3 weeks from the time you were exposed to chickenpox for the spots to start appearing.
- ◆ You'll need to stay away from school, nursery or work until all the spots have crusted over. This is usually 5 days after the spots first appeared.

Morning routine

- If your child is not booked in for Breakfast Club, they should not be in school before 8.35am. Children who arrive before this time will be put into Breakfast Club and a charge of £2 will be made to parents.
