



## Parent School Agreement

Christ The King RC Primary School has been asked by The Department for Education (DFE) to allow key groups of children back into school as part of a phased approach to the re-opening of schools.

To enable this to happen safely and effectively, we have created a home school agreement that will ensure the school and parents are working together to mitigate the risks of catching or spreading the virus.

### **We (school) will:**

- Carry out a thorough risk assessment to enable us to make what we feel is the right decision regarding a planned re-opening.
- Do everything that we can to minimise risk e.g. smaller groupings, different drop off and pick up times, different locations for break and lunchtimes, alteration of classrooms and use of resources. Stay in the same 'Bubbles' wherever possible.
- Ensure that our staff maintain a high level of personal hygiene, in particular with regards to handwashing.
- Ensure that we encourage the children to wash their hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.
- Ensure that a member of school staff supervises your child if they are poorly while we are waiting for them to be collected (please note that school staff will need to wear personal protective equipment [PPE]) at this time.

### **You (parents) will:**

- Ensure you arrive promptly to drop off and collect your child so that the measures the school has put in place for social distancing etc. work effectively.
- Understand that even with a variety of procedures put in place to limit risk, social distancing is not possible in a primary school.
- Understand that some of the children that will be in school are the children of frontline staff who are in daily contact with Covid19 patients and, as such, have an increased risk of carrying the virus.
- Stick to the allocated group and related drop off and collection times. If your child is in Year 6 and walking home, it is expected that they will maintain social distancing.
- Collect your child immediately if your child shows any symptoms of illness on site and give permission to us to inform other parents by text message if we have a suspected case of Covid.
- Collect your child immediately if your child behaves in a way that puts themselves or others at risk
- Understand that the 'Bubble' your child is in will be sent home for 14 days should there be a positive case of Coronavirus.
- Ensure that your child is sent into school with all the items they need for the day e.g. Water bottle, snack, lunch (if staying all day) and no other unnecessary items.
